Next, we continued drilling with the stained disc always in the middle of the drilling field to ensure we were not proceeding superiorly or inferiorly. This stained disc initially appears like a blue region and after further progression of drilling, it suddenly enlarges indicating the anterior boundary of the pathology. This is the evidence that we have reached the herniated fragment (in cases with only foraminal or lateral disc herniation). After reaching the herniated disc using a fine probe, the fragment was removed with the aid of small pituitary and ringworm (Fig. 2B, C). If there is some foraminal stenosis, the ringworm should be used to undercut the bony prominences and care should be taken to avoid any breach in the medial wall of the transverse foramen. After the removal of the herniated fragment, since nerve root bulges out after CSF flows into it, the decompression is confirmed. Finally, adequate decompression can be verified by using a root probe to palpate the superior and inferior pedicles along the course of the nerve root and to check for the filling of the nerve root in the foramen (Fig. 3A, C)."

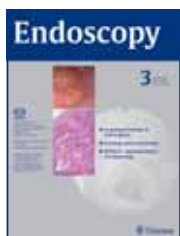
