Important: Incorrect English can result in the immediate rejection of your manuscript whereas correct English will facilitate a speedy publication process. It is in your own interest to ensure that your paper has been read by a native English speaker. Alternatively, you should use a copy-editing service like "American Journal Experts" if you have concerns about the English in your manuscript.

Types of Manuscript

- 1. Original Research Papers: < 4000 words, excluding references, tables, figures and figure legends. Papers published in Planta Medica follow the IRDMACR structure: Introduction, Results, Discussion, Materials and Methods, Acknowledgements, Conflict of Interest Statement, References, Figure Legends. All graphics have to be uploaded separately, preferably as TIFF files. For correct layout see full version.
- **2. Reviews:** They should be as concise as possible and do not need to include experimental details.

General Structure of all Manuscript Types

The **first page** of the manuscript should contain:

- 1. Title (concise, maximum words: 20)
- **2. Full author names** (including the first name) and the name of their institute(s), using superscript numbers after name to indicate affiliations.
- **3. Correspondence:** For the corresponding author (to whom all correspondence (including galley proofs) is to be sent), Name, title, full postal address, telephone and fax number as well as email address has to be displayed.

The second page should contain the

Abstract: Maximum: 250 words

The manuscript file (tables should be included at the end of the manuscript) should contain the main text and figure legends. Figures have to be uploaded separately, preferably as TIFF file. For correct layout of all figures see detailed author instructions.

Keywords: 4 – 6, not more than 6, including botanical name of the plant and botanical family

Abbreviations: Alphabetical (excluding standard abbreviations, see full version for complete list)

References

References, including those in tables and figure legends, should be numbered sequentially in square brackets [2,30]. Original Research articles should not exceed 45 references.

Reference list (collected at the end of the manuscript) as in the following examples:
