How can I download books?

- Via the MedOne app. The MedOne app allows users download and read offline e-books, journal articles, and watch videos on the go.

Where can I download the MedOne app?

- The app is freely available for Android and iOS devices in the Google Playstore and in the iTunes app store.

What new features are there within MedOne Education?

Can I still use my old personal account?

- No, you can no longer use your old account. You need to create a new account within IP range of your institution. Once you create it, you will then have access to MedOne from virtually everywhere (see MedOne at home above).
